CSUDH is dedicated to protecting its students, faculty, and staff during an emergency. Following are the steps one should take when receiving a bomb threat over the phone.

- * Do not put the caller on hold or transfer the call.
- * Do not interrupt the caller.
- * Call University Police by calling 9-1-1 from a campus phone.
- * Identify yourself to the Police Dispatcher.
- * Make sure you give the Police Dispatcher your exact location, including building and room number.
- * Notify your supervisor.
- * Follow University Police instructions.
- * Do not use radios, cell phones, or activate fire alarm pull stations, since these frequencies may trigger the device.

After evacuating, be sure to assemble at a safe distance from the building and have a barrier between you and the building.
