The purpose of the **Toros Teach Los Angeles** (TTLA) Scholarship is to financially support CSUDH Students who aspire to become teachers or counselors for students in Preschool – 3rd Grade in under-resourced schools in the Los Angeles area.

Minimum Requirements to be Considered a Scholarship Candidate:

- Plan or desire to work with children in preschool through 3rd Grade.
- Interest in new Pre-Kindergarten – 3rd Grade Credential and other credentials with Early Childhood options.
- Plan or desire to work at an under-resourced school in the Los Angeles area.
- Enrolled in one of the following BA, credential, or MA in Education programs:

Undergraduate BA: Liberal Studies or Child Development Majors with the following Degree Options:

- Child Development: Early Developmental and Learning Concentration
- Child Development: General Elective Option
- Child Development: Management & Administration
- Child Development: Counseling and Family Services
- Liberal Studies: Early Learning and Teaching Option ?
- Liberal Studies: Human Development Option
- Liberal Studies: English Language and Teaching Option ?
- Liberal Studies: Educating Children with Disabilities Option

OR

Enrolled in or applying to one of these Credential Programs or Master's Degree Programs:

- Multiple Subject (MSCP)
- Early Childhood Special Education (ESCE)
- Education Specialist: Mild/Moderate Support Needs (MMSN)
- Education Specialist: Extensive Support Needs (ESN)

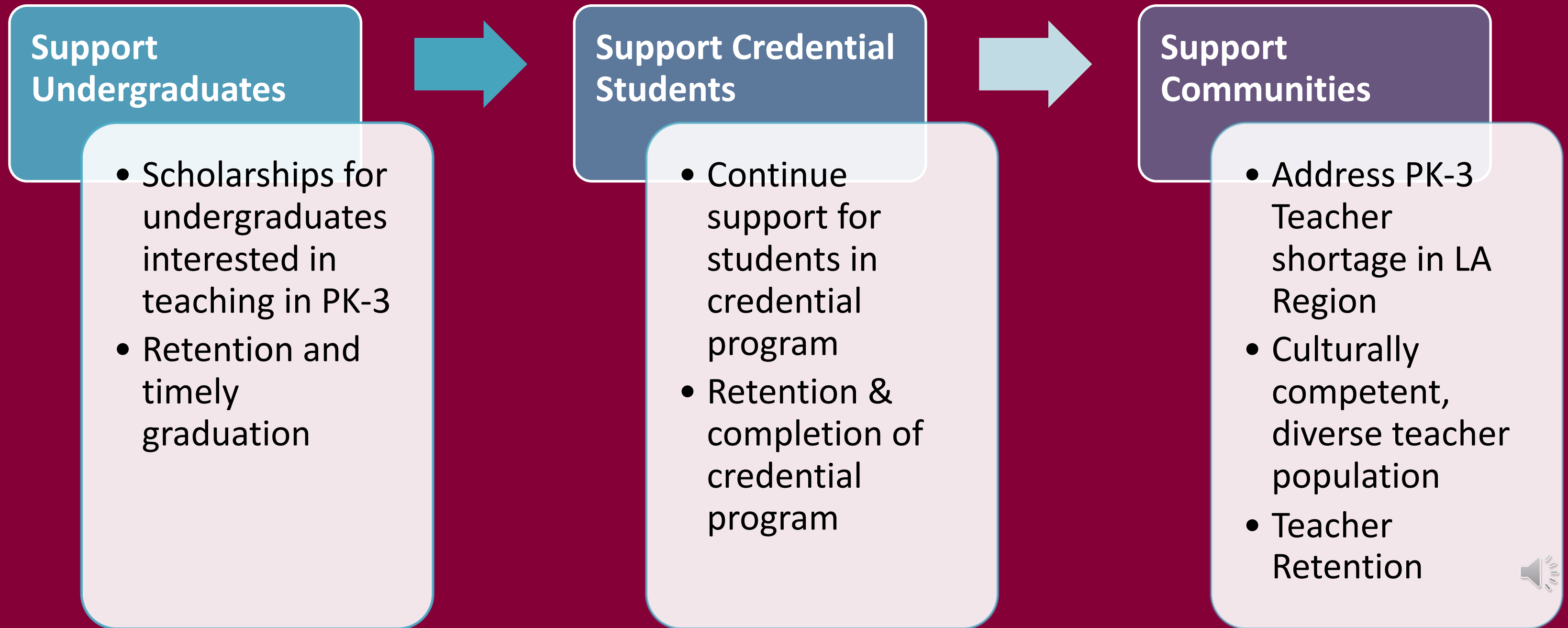
