I must maintain a 2.0 GPA; if my GPA drops below a 2.0 I will be placed on academic probation.	
I must complete all courses in the major with a grade of "C" or better. A grade of "C-" or lower is not considered a satisfactory grade and will require me to retake the course.	
Statistics is required for all child development majors	
Courses are to be taken in a particular sequence and I am expected to adhere to that sequence. No exceptions!	
All fieldwork must have departmental/instructor approval.	
Most lower division GE requirements should be completed prior to enrolling in courses for the major. (Transfer students need transcripts that are GE certified by the community college.)	
Child Development courses taken at another college or university must have been taken within 10 years of my entrance into the Child Development major at CSUDH. I must retake any course in the major that does not meet this requirement.	
I will be required to have TB (Tuberculosis) and Live Scan clearance when working on various field sites and possibly for labs associated with courses.	
Lab work associated with different courses as well as Directed Field Work are required of all students. Having prior experience of working with children is not a substitute for meeting program requirements.
