Question:

Is it still required to wear face coverings on campus during the summer?

Yes. Face coverings will continue to be required for: All persons in classrooms, laboratories, and the Student Health Center; At least 10 days if you have been in close contact with someone who tested positive for COVID-19, even if you are fully vaccinated; At least 10 days if you have tested positive for COVID-19.

While face coverings will no longer be required in most indoor settings, to help prevent the spread of COVID-19, you are encouraged to use them, especially when in large groups. If you are more comfortable wearing a face covering, please continue to do so. Additionally, please respect individuals who choose to wear them on a voluntary basis.
