Academic Senate Resolution
Establishment of a Faculty Development Center
EPC 11-06 (MSP 5/4/11)

Resolved that the Academic Senate, CSU-DH strongly recommends that a Faculty Development Center be established to provide and coordinate resources for faculty success in teaching, research and service.

Rationale: A fundamental component of most university and college campuses is a Faculty Development Center that offers a variety of resources to faculty. These centers provide training for faculty in computer and technology related matters, they provide a forum for a wide range of other pedagogical issues, and they support faculty research, teaching, and service. These activities are coordinated by faculty and/or staff, and they are carried out through workshops, informal discussions, visiting speakers, etc. Increasingly, many resources are available online, and a complementary Faculty Development Center website can direct faculty to resources related to teaching, research, and service.
