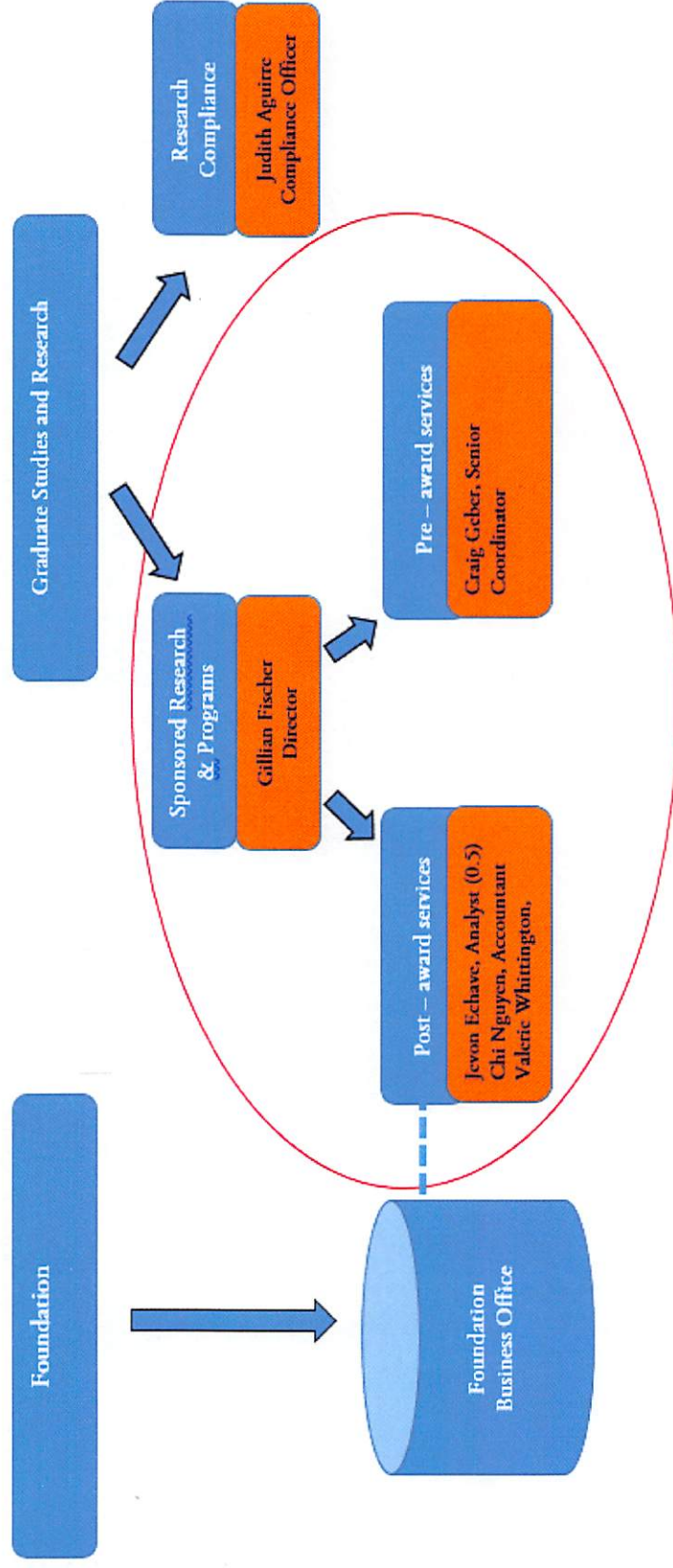


Organizational Structure

1. **The Role of Sponsored Research and Programs**
 - a. Provides faculty with expert guidance on both University and External Sponsor Policies
 - i. Pre Award Staff are Certified Research Administrators
 - b. Keep up with frequently changing Federal regulations, Individual Sponsor Policies, and Program Guidelines
 - c. Thoroughly review Proposal Guidelines and Proposals to ensure compliance
 - i. Non-compliant proposals may be returned without review
 - d. Ensure budgets are accurate & costs are allowable
 - i. Protects the University, College & Principal Investigator from disallowances/shortfalls
 - e. Review and negotiate award documents on behalf of the University
 - f. Assist with financial management & required reporting (including cost share)
