### **Topics of Discussion and Actions Taken**

In our first meeting we elected a representative to serve on the Online Hybrid Learning Committee (OHLC). The EPC 2022 term started with a discussion about Academic Program Discontinuance. Some progress were made in clarifying the various nuances, but we decided to table this pending further research. We also had a discussion on royalties, but some members felt that this issue might be best addressed between EPC and FPC. Consequently, issues of Royalties were left as an item that the office of the graduate school will take on. EPC co-sponsored several Town Halls with the Senate Exec and Academic Affairs for program elevation. EPC sponsored several resolutions in the Senate (see the senate log).

Overall, the committee worked on several policies and programs elevations:

- Labor Studies Program elevation to department
- Women Studies Program elevation to department
- Approval of the Super Senior Policy
- Asian-Pacific Program elevation to department
- Approval of the CEL resolution
- Approval of the Criteria and Rubric hybrid and Online Learning instruction
- Approval of the procedures for establishing schools
- Approval of a name change from the Department of Health Sciences to the Division of Public Health and Health Sciences.

In 2021-2022 academic year we were unable to conclude for Program Discontinuance. However, some progress has been made to solving this program. A policy resolution should be ready in the Fall 2022.
