Reinvesting in Instructional and Support Facilities

Providing the appropriate facilities to meet the growing needs of the university is essential to the success of the university. Aging facilities and equipment can negatively impact the campus. In an effort to maximize the facilities and support instruction on campus, it is critical that we reinvest (above the annual allocation of \$491,000) in our facilities. As a result, one time funds are being requested for the following:
