### Class of 2009 Celebrates Commencement

More than 2,000 new graduates of California State University, Dominguez Hills participated in commencement exercises at the Home Depot Center located on the Carson campus. The master's hooding ceremony, which took place on Thursday, May 21, welcomed 490 graduate students, their families and friends to the Tennis Stadium. Jamie McCourt, CEO of the Los Angeles Dodgers gave the keynote address. The following morning, 1,525 undergraduate students celebrated graduation on the facility's main soccer field. U.S. Secretary of Labor Hilda Solis saluted the Class of 2009 with her keynote address.

Solis urged graduates to keep striving in the face of difficult economic times. "We need you to help us overcome this challenge," Solis said. "We need people like you to step up. We need your enthusiasm, energy, and your creativity."

Joining the undergraduates in their celebration were 20 CSU Dominguez Hills alumni representatives. In addition to marching in the commencement processional, alumni had a chance to connect with and support graduates, and reconnect with each other and faculty.
