Sam Enriquez: Above the Fold at the Wall Street Journal



Just a month after his promotion to national news editor of the *Wall Street Journal* in 2008, Sam Enriquez found himself reaching back more than two decades to his courses in economics from California State University, Dominguez Hills.

That fall, Lehman Brothers Holdings Inc., a global financial services firm and

then the fourth-largest investment bank in the U.S., declared bankruptcy, ushering in a historic autumn of frozen credit markets and government bailouts as the national and global economy teetered on the brink of collapse. After years of reporting and editing general news, Enriquez said, with understatement, that what he learned in his macroeconomics classes would "prove immensely important" in helping him understand, interpret and help edit the daily onslaught of news that evolved into the biggest story of the decade.
