



Frequently Asked Questions

Where can I buy tickets?

Tickets will only be sold from the Dodgers website or online at dodgers.com/csudh and should be purchased there only.

What do I receive with my purchase?

In addition to a **seat** to the game, you will receive a **co-branded CSUDH/Dodger cap**. All caps will be distributed at a designated location within the stadium, on the day of the game only. The cap will not be available prior to or after the game and will not be available for sale at any time. Limited quantities of the cap will be available, so purchase your tickets as soon as possible before supplies run out. Proceeds from all ticket purchases for CSUDH Day at Dodger Stadium will also go towards the **CSUDH Alumni Scholarship** and will be provided to CSUDH by the Dodgers post-game.

Where do I pickup my cap?

The gates to Dodger Stadium open as early as 11:10am on Sunday, September 25. The caps will be distributed at the **Centerfield Plaza**, between the **Sandy Koufax and Jackie Robinson statues**. It is strongly recommended to be at the stadium by the first inning because hats will stop being distributed an hour after the first pitch or at the start of the second inning. Therefore, **caps may stop being distributed at or before 2:10pm**. Get there early to secure your co-branded hat! Limited supplies available. Distribution will be on a first come first served basis.

When is the last day to purchase tickets?

The last day to purchase tickets is on **game day, September 25, unless sold out**. The Dodgers will announce if this game has sold out prior to game time, however we recommend that you purchase as soon as possible because the Dodgers/CSUDH co-branded cap is available in limited quantities.

Will transportation to the game be provided?

While **transportation** will not be provided for all ticket purchasers, Metro offers free bus rides from the South Bay and Union Station to the Stadium for home games. In fact, **Harbor Gateway Transit Center** is just 2 miles away from CSUDH. View the locations here:

Is there accessible seating at the stadium?

Accessible seating is available on every level of the stadium. Guests may purchase tickets for accessible seating by clicking the “ADA Tickets” link at several places on Dodgers website, or by selecting “Yes, show me accessible seating.” on the right of any ticket selection webpage. Guests may also contact the Dodgers’ ticket office by calling 866-DODGERS ext. 8 with any specific ADA seating requirements. In addition to seating, are there accessible parking spaces available?

The **accessible parking spaces** required by law are located in parking lots B, D, G, L, N, & P and are reserved for those properly holding and using a valid, state-issued disabled parking placard or license plate, whether or not the drivers have paid for preferred parking in any of those lots. Parking cashiers and attendants are happy to direct drivers of eligible vehicles to these areas. Accessible parking stalls are available on a first-come and first-served basis. Once full, fans will be directed to the nearest lot where standard parking stalls are still available.

I’m a student, am I able to buy tickets to this game?

Do I need to purchase a ticket for my baby?

Children 3 years or younger are not required to purchase a ticket, but they will not be eligible for a co-branded cap. A ticket must be purchased to receive the co-branded cap.
