Note Taking Strategies!

When taking notes remember the 5 R's.

- ✓ **Record:** During the lecture, write all meaningful information legibly.
- ✓ **Reduce:** After lecture, write a summary of ideas and facts using key words as cue words.
- ✓ **Recite:** Recite all the information in your own words without looking at your textbook.
- ✓ **Reflect:** Think about your own opinion and ideas. Raise questions and record original ideas.
- ✓ **Review:** Before reading new material, take 10 minutes to review your old notes. Skim over the main ideas and details.
