

Projecting -\$12 billion shortfall

State Revenues project \$7.9 billion above January Forecast

\$321.9 billion state budget

Unknown Factors

- Awaiting Chancellor's Office review of May Revise
- Now until June will consist of Assembly & Senate discussions, which may impact final budget.
- The state will have to agree on a final "budget deal"
- How will the state manage the -\$12B deficit?
- State financial outlook beyond 2025-26.
- Can we rely on the compact?









What does this mean for the CSU and CSUDH?

Stay the Course; continue right-sizing the campus

Wait until July for final budget
