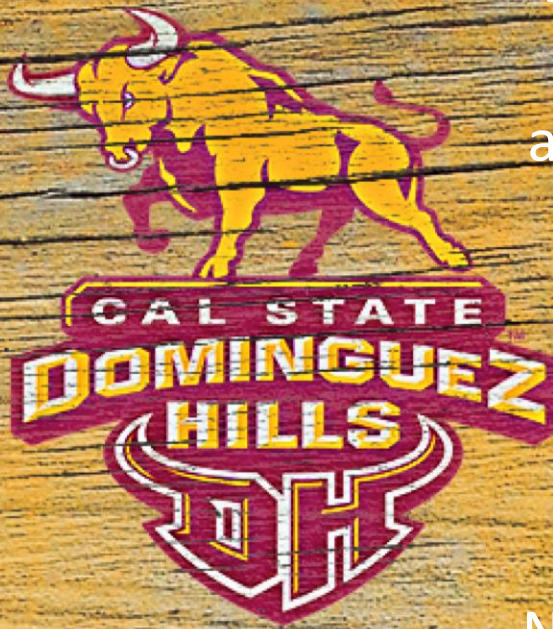

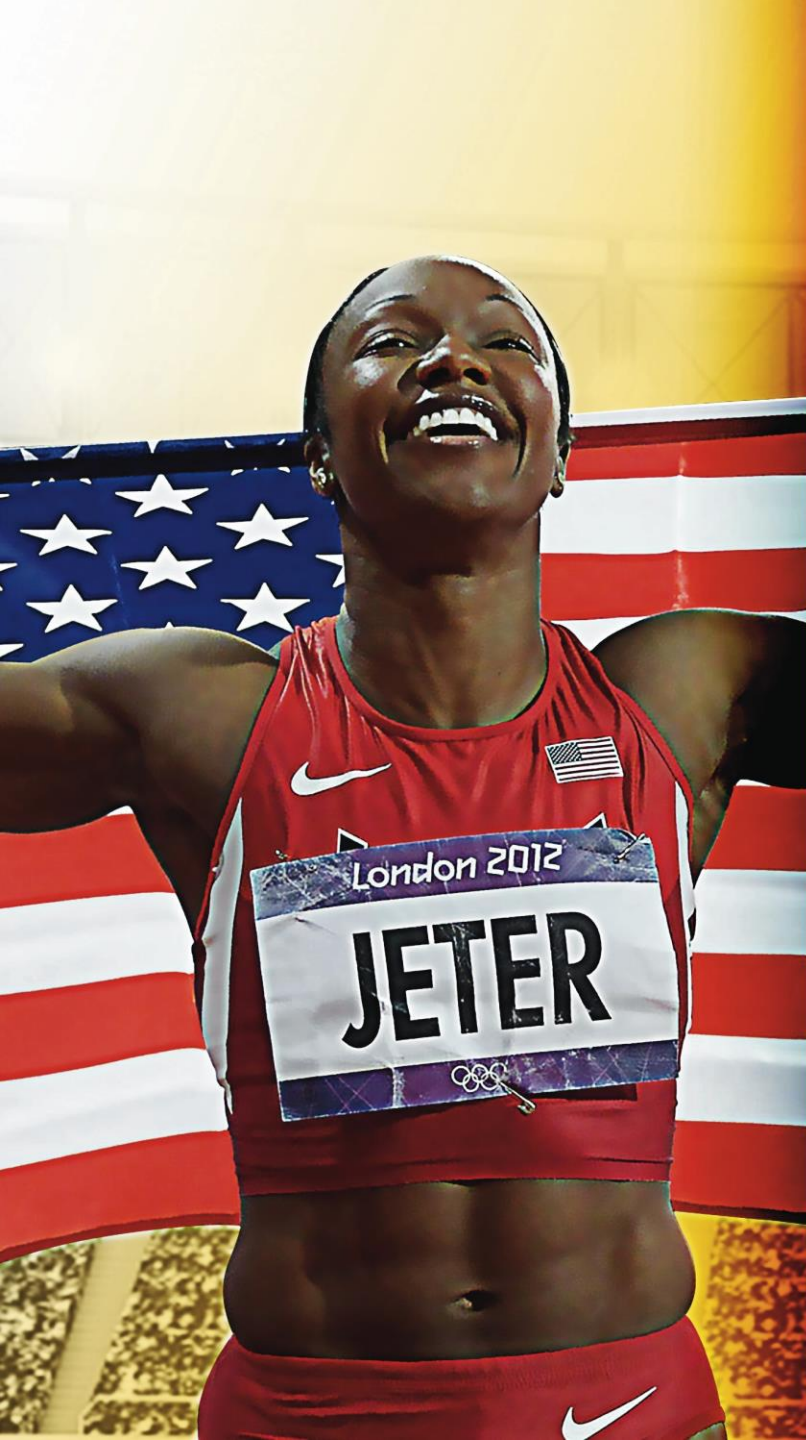
ATHLETICS ALUMNI

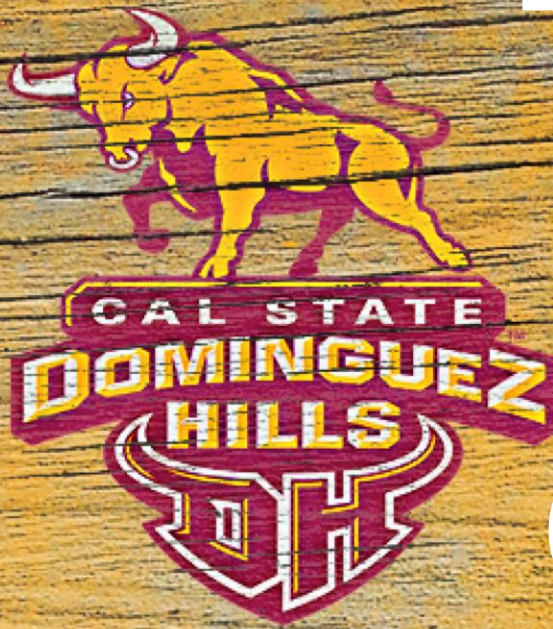
