The College of the Extended & International Education at California State University, Dominguez Hills offers an integrated program that combines language instruction, conversational activities, computer training and recreational activities into one fun-filled learning experience.

Our English as a Second Language (ESL) and American Culture Camp gives students ages ten to eighteen the opportunity to increase their skill level to comfortably communicate in English, while learning American history, government and culture. Students also benefit by experiencing college life in a beautiful academic setting.

Students can observe classes and tour the campus, visit school TV studio, have oncamera interview experience, communicate with the teachers and students and have a more comprehensive understanding of the diverse American high school life. All instructors have a minimum of a Master's in TEFL/TESOL, Applied Degree Linguistics, or in a closely related field. All have many years of teaching experience either in the Program here or at an equivalent program in another university or private institution.

Students who successfully complete the ESL & American Culture Camp will receive a certificate of participation.
