REQUIREMENTS		
t is recommended that before you begin this application process that you thoroughly read through these instructions and create or gather the following items (see below for specific information):		
\square Locate CBEST official passing results		
\square Write a Letter of Interest		
\square Update your Resume		
$\hfill\square$ Request 2 Letters of Recommendation (one from site principal or direct supervisor)		
$\hfill\square$ Request a verification of experience from your district or employing agency.		
\square Request transcripts from every higher education institute you attended		
ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS		
There are two parts to applying to the SLP Program:		
\square Part I. University Application through Cal State Apply		
\square Part II. School Leadership Program (SLP) Application		
Both the Program and the University applications must be completed in full and submitted by the deadline in order to be considered for admission. Incomplete		

applications will <u>not</u> be reviewed.



APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Part I. University Application Procedures: (3 TOTAL TASKS TO COMPLETE)

☐ TASK 1: Apply for admission to the University by completing the <u>Graduate Online</u> <u>Application</u> at Cal State Apply. Be sure to select and apply for the upcoming Fall Term, not the Summer Term. The University application requires a \$70 nonrefundable application fee. <u>Click here</u> for Cal State Apply Instruction Guide. <u>Click</u> <u>here</u> to watch a short "How-To" Video to ensure you select the correct program.
□ TASK 2: Submit one set of official sealed transcripts directly to the CSUDH Office of Admissions & Records, 1000 E. Victoria St., Carson, CA 90747. All academic transcripts must be submitted from all undergraduate and any post-graduate work. Electronic transcripts are only considered official when sent directly from the issuing institution. Enter the following email address if your issuing institution will be sending an official electronic transcript: admissions@csudh.edu . Note: CSUDH students/alums do not need to submit CSUDH transcripts, but DO need to submit them for all other institutions attended.
☐ TASK 3: Cal State Apply - Supporting Information Quadrant under "My Application" - The Cal State Apply (University) application will ask you to add your experiences; you may opt out of this when prompted. ALL supporting documents must be submitted with the Program application under Part 2 (SMApply).
IMPORTANT MUST READ: The University application on Cal State Apply must be completed before completing the online Program application. Once you have completed the University application and fee, you will receive a CSUDH Student ID number (usually within 7 - 10 working days). Your Student ID number is necessary for you to complete the Program application.
Part 2. School Leadership Program (SLP) Application (9 TOTAL TASKS TO COMPLETE)
☐ TASK 1: SLP Program Application: Complete the online application at Apply Now on the college's website page. You will be asked to provide the dates of your CBEST, your employment history and upload your current resume and letter of interest. You will need to verify employment history and CBEST results by uploading documentation late in the application process.

ave this the	K 2: SLP Minimum 3.0 Grade Point Average: A <i>minimum</i> of a 3.0 grade point rage in the last 60 semester or 90 quarter units is required. If you do NOT meet requirement, then provide verification of a minimum combined score of 1000 on Graduate Record Examination (GRE - General Aptitude Test) OR a minimum score 00 on the Miller Analogies Test.
you	ou CANNOT meet this requirement through any of the options listed above, then will need to submit a SLP Low GPA Petition for Exception. See form for more ails.

	K 5: Verification of Valid Clear or Life Credential: Upload a copy of one of the owing: For more info
	A valid California clear or life teaching credential requiring a bachelor's degree and a program of professional preparation, including student teaching;
t	A valid California clear or life Designated Subjects Teaching Credential, provided the holder also possesses a bachelor's or higher degree from a regionally accredited college or university; OR

A valid clear or life California Pupil Personnel Services Credential, Teacher Librarian Services Credential, Speech Language Pathology Services Credential,

Clinical or Rehabilitative Services Credential, or a School Nurse Services Credential, requiring a bachelor's degree and a program of professional

preparation, including field practice or the equivalent.



re su	SK 6: SLP Letter of Recommendation 1 from Site Principal: Upload a letter of ecommendation from your current site principal (or equivalent) clearly stating their apport of your application for graduate studies. Letter must be written within the ear prior to the application deadline and signed.	
an ch	SK 7: SLP Letter of Recommendation 2: Upload a letter of recommendation from individual who can evaluate your leadership potential, success as an educator, and haracter. Letter must be written on the official letterhead of the referee's place of imployment, written within the year prior to the application deadline and signed.	
☐ TASK 8: Five Year Verification of Experience: Upload your verification of five		
sc ex pu or pa or su	successful, full-time experience in a public school, nonpublic school, or private hool of equivalent status located in California or another state, or a combination of sperience earned in California and another state. This experience may be teaching, upil personnel work, librarianship, health services, clinical or rehabilitative services, a combination of teaching and school services equal to five years. Substitute or ext-time service does not apply. Verification of experience must be on the district remploying agency letterhead and signed by the superintendent, assistant sperintendent, director of personnel, or director of human resources. School or strict personnel other than the applicant must verify all experience.	
☐ TASK 9: TargetSuccess Leadership Questionnaire: The TargetSuccess is an easy-		
ef Di	buse online questionnaire that assesses your disposition towards becoming an fective school leader. You will download the TargetSuccess Leadership Sketch rections from SMApply and complete the questionnaire. You will receive your School eader Sketch Results (Detailed Profile) in a pdf format that you will upload.	

SLP Appeal/Exceptions Policy

Students may file a petition for exception to some SLP requirements or regulations by filing an appropriate exception request form. Petitions are reviewed by the SLP Chair, with faculty consultation. Note: For some requirements such as basic skills, valid credential, there are no exceptions. Both the SLP Low GPA Petition for Exception and SLP Exception Request forms can be found online by selecting Forms from the main menu at the College of Education (COE) website: www.csudh.edu/coe. The forms will be listed under Graduate Education Division heading.
