FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS: STUDENT EDITION

WHAT IS DSP?	<b>DSP</b> is not a test; it is a free online <b>survey</b> . You will complete a reading, write an essay, and answer a series of questions about your reading and writing habits. The survey will recommend which First Year Composition ( <b>FYC</b> ) course might best suit your needs but you make the final course selection.
WHO IS REQUIRED TO DSP?	<b>All</b> entering first-time freshman are required to complete <b>DSP</b> unless they have already received college credit for First Year Composition (English).
HOW IS DSP ADMINISTERED?	<b>DSP</b> is a free online survey accessed through <b>Blackboard</b> . You will log in, and at the conclusion of <b>DSP</b> , select the <b>FYC</b> course you will take your first semester or year at CSUDH.
CAN I TAKE DSP AT CSUDH?	<b>Yes</b> , you can complete <b>DSP</b> at any computer lab on campus prior to orientation. For log-in issues, call 310-243-2500 or visit Welch Hall A-370.
HOW LONG DOES IT TAKE TO COMPLETE DSP?	You can complete <b>DSP</b> in one sitting, or over the course of several days. You should plan for 3-4 hours minimum to complete.
HOW ARE DSP AND ORIENTATION RELATED?	In order to enroll in an <b>FYC</b> course at orientation, you are required to complete <b>DSP</b> at least <b>one week before</b> orientation.
WHAT IF I DO NOT COMPLETE DSP?	You will not be placed in an <b>FYC</b> course at orientation if you have not completed <b>DSP</b> . <b>FYC</b> courses fill up very quickly; if you have not completed <b>DSP</b> before orientation you are much less likely to get the course you want.
DO I NEED TO COMPLETE DSP IF I RECEIVED AP, IB, OR COLLEGE CREDIT FOR ENGLISH?	<b>No</b> , if you received credit for First Year Composition (English) through an English AP exam, an International Baccalaureate course, or a course at another college or university, then you <b>do not</b> need to complete <b>DSP</b> .
ONCE I HAVE COMPLETED DSP, WILL I HEAR BACK ABOUT MY DSP ESSAY?	<b>No</b> , you will not hear back about your essay. The purpose of the essay-writing portion of <b>DSP</b> is for you to reflect on your writing skills so you can make an educated decision about which <b>FYC</b> course is best for you.
ONCE I HAVE COMPLETED DSP, CAN I CHANGE MY COURSE SELECTION?	No, your <b>DSP</b> decision is binding and therefore you should consider your options <b>carefully</b> before choosing a course. In exceptional cases, you may appeal your <b>DSP</b> choice before the end of the first week of classes by contacting the DSP Coordinator (wac@csudh.edu).
WHO WILL READ MY DSP ESSAY?	While <b>DSP</b> essays are not reviewed by the university or department of English, your <b>FYC</b> instructor has access to your essay and may choose to incorporate it into the course. This is one reason you should put a genuine effort into your essay. The essay will not be graded and will not be used to change your course selection.
