2019-2020 Independent Status Determination Form

- At any time on or after July 1, 2018 did the director of a runaway or homeless youth basic center or transitional living program determine that you were an unaccompanied youth who was homeless or were self-supporting and at risk of being homeless? *Attach supporting documentation.*
- At any time on or after July 1, 2018 did your high school or school district homeless liaison determine that you were an unaccompanied youth who was homeless or self-supporting and at risk of being homeless? *Attach supporting documentation.*
- At any time on or after July 1, 2018 did the director of an emergency shelter or transitional housing program funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development determine that you were an unaccompanied youth who was homeless or were self-supporting and at risk of being homeless? *Attach supporting documentation.*
