

The Financial Aid Process: Steps 1 – 3

Step 1:

- Each new academic year, submit your FAFSA or CA Dream Act application between October 1st – March 2nd
- If you happen to miss the March 2nd priority consideration deadline, you may still submit your application

Step 2: SUBMIT DOCS

- Monitor your "<u>To Do List</u>" and <u>CSUDH Toro Email</u>
- Submit any required documents to the Financial Aid Office
- Priority Document
 Consideration Deadline is
 THURSDAY, MAY 13, 2022

Step 3: GET OFFERED AID

- Documents are reviewed and offer notifications are sent
- Grants/scholarships are automatically accepted for all students
- Loans must be accepted or declined by the student
- Currently, students do not have access to accept or decline loans

Financial Aid Offer Notifications

Notification messages are sent via email to the **Toro Email accounts** for all students.

To view your Financial Aid Offer, you must login to your myCSUDH account > select "Student Center"
 > under Finances, select "View Financial Aid"

There are (2) types of Financial Aid Offers:

- An Estimated offer (if additional documents are required to verify eligibility)
- An actual Offer (if no additional documents are required)

Information contained under your "View Financial Aid" link:

- Amounts for federal, state and college/university grants, scholarships, and loans
- Estimated Cost of Attendance (COA) Budget

Grants

Federal Grants

- Federal Pell Grant
 - Limited to up 6-years of full-time enrollment
 - Pell Grant funds received at a community college count towards the 6-year eligibility limit
- Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant (FSEOG)
- Iraq and Afghanistan Service Grant

State Grants

- FAFSA and CA DREAM applicants may be considered for state grants
- Cal Grant A and B
- Chafee Grant (for foster youth)
- Middle Class Scholarship (MCS)
 - Not a Scholarship; it's based on income & FAFSA submission by March 2nd

Self Help: Loans & Work-Study

Federal Direct Loans

- Borrowed money that <u>must be repaid</u>
- **Subsidized Loan:** The federal government pays the interest while the student is in school
- Unsubsidized Loan: Interest begins to accrue immediately
- Federal Direct Parent Loan (PLUS)
 - Based on credit
 - Parents may borrow up to the student's total cost of attendance, less any financial aid funds received
 - Parents must apply online at <u>www.studentaid.gov</u>

Federal Work-Study

- Federal funds
- Part-time employment for on or offcampus positions
- Based on financial need
- Available upon request

CA Dream Loan

- For Undergraduate, Teaching Credential, and Graduate Dream students
- Borrowed money that must be repaid
- Subsidized Loan









Now, let's review Steps 4 – 6









The Financial Aid Process: Steps 4 – 6

Step 4: REGISTER FOR CLASSES

- Register for classes
- Financial aid funds may be prorated if a student is enrolled in less than 12 units
- > 12 or more units = 100%
- \rightarrow 9 11 units = 75%
- \rightarrow 6 8 units = 50%
- Enrollment in less than 6 units, may be <u>ineligible</u> for some types of aid (e.g. loans or state grants)

Step 5: TUITION IS PAID

- Financial aid funds are credited to a student's CSUDH Student Account 1-week before classes begin
- Tuition and/or housing fees are paid first
- Any <u>EXCESS</u> remaining money will be issued to the student as a financial aid **REFUND**

Step 6: REFUND PROCESS

- Refunds are processed by the Student Financial Services Office and refunds are not processed by the Financial Aid Office
- <u>Two methods of payment</u>:
- **Direct Deposit** to a student's bank account **(or)**
- A mailed check if there is no direct deposit enrollment

Installment Plans for Tuition & Fees

Description

- Plans cover all mandatory registration fees
- There is a \$33 non-refundable Administrative Service fee
- Interest FREE for CA resident students
- Students enroll online via their MyCSUDH student portal
- Payment options are based on the date of enrollment in the plan

Requirements

- Student must be registered for classes to enroll
- New students may not register until they attend New Student Orientation (NSO)
- Each semester, Installment Payment Plan information may be accessed from the CLASS SCHEDULE





All students living on campus are <u>REQUIRED</u> to complete the COVID-19 Vaccination Self-Certification form that is now available on their <u>My.CSUDH.edu</u> portal. This self-certification provides the campus with critical information needed to maintain a safe campus environment. Housing applicants who fail to complete the COVID-19 Vaccination Self-Certification form will NOT be assigned to a space in Housing.

CSUDH has also implemented a <u>COVID-19 surveillance testing program</u>, which requires students in University Housing to undergo <u>MANDATORY</u> weekly testing, regardless of vaccination status. All current Housing residents are also required to complete a daily COVID-19 symptom self-screening using the <u>iToros</u> mobile app.

The main University Housing administrative office is now located in the Commons Building of the new Residence Hall (building 72 on the <u>CSUDH campus map</u>).










CSUDH Financial Aid TV (FATV)
