#### 1. Required Courses (9 units)

Course	Semester	Substitution
HIS 300 Theory and Practice of History (3) - Pre-requisite: HIS 120 and HIS 121; C or better required - To avoid delayed graduation, students must complete HIS 300 during their junior year.		
HIS 400 Pro-Seminar in History (3) - Pre-requisite: C or better in HIS 300; C or better required		
HIS 490 Senior Seminar in History (3) - Pre-requisite: C or better in HIS 400; C or better required		

#### 2. Three Courses in Non-U.S. History (9 units)

Select three courses in non-U.S. history (representing at least two regions) from the courses numbered 305, 310-320, 360-369, 370, or when the subject is appropriate HIS 395.

#### 3. Three Courses in U.S. History (9 units)

Select three courses in U.S. history. Two should be period courses, selected from the courses numbered 330-336. One should be topical, selected from the courses numbered 340-359 or when the subject is appropriate: HIS 375, HIS 376, HIS 379, HIS 380 or HIS 395.

**4. Four upper-division courses (12 units)**

Select four additional upper-division courses, one of which must be a topical course (courses numbered 301, 302, 340-353, 354, 370-390, and 395). The other three may be any upper-division courses. **Note: HIS 355, HIS 375 or HIS 376 may be double-counted as an upper-division Humanities GE. HIS 340, HIS 348, HIS 352, HIS 354, or HIS 380 may be double-counted as an upper-division Social and Behavioral Sciences GE.**
