2. Three Courses in Non-U.S. History (9 units)

Select three courses in non-U.S. history (representing at least two regions) from the courses numbered 305, 310-320, 360-369, 370, or HIS 395 when the subject is appropriate.

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3. Three Courses in U.S. History (9 units)

Select three courses in U.S. history. Two should be period courses, selected from the courses numbered 330-336. One should be topical, selected from the courses numbered 340-359 or HIS 376, HIS 379, HIS 380 or HIS 395 when the subject is appropriate.

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4. Four upper division courses (12 units)

Select four additional upper-division courses, one of which must be a topical course (courses numbered 301, 302, 340-353, 354, 370-390, and 395). The other three may be any upper-division courses. Note: HIS 355 or HIS 376 may be double-counted for credit in the major and for UD GE credit in Area F1. HIS 340, HIS 348, HIS 354, or HIS 380 may be double-counted for credit in the major and for upper-division and for UD GE credit in Area F3.

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Notes:

Students should satisfy the Graduation Writing Assessment Requirement during their junior year. This requirement may be met by either a) completing ENG 350 with a C grade or better, or b) by passing the Graduation Writing Exam. Students are encouraged to attempt the exam before enrolling in ENG 350.
