# WEEKEND CLASSES

## SATURDAY COURSES

NOTE: All Saturday classes from IDS and LBR are now classified as “hybrid” courses. University policy defines a hybrid course as “one which integrates on-line with traditional face to face activities....[and] in which a portion not less than one third nor more than two thirds of face to face time is replaced by online activities” (AAAP029.001). Please be aware that, in accord with university policy, reduced time in the classroom must be balanced by additional out-of-class hours of instruction done online.

“Traditional” classes meet for approximately 45 hours. This means that, in a hybrid course where you spend approximately 28 hours in class, the remaining 17 hours of “instructional activity” have to be offered online outside of the classroom. Regular homework assignments, readings, etc. are additional.
