

# TURNITIN AND SAFARI COMPATIBILITY ON MACOS 10.14

## PROBLEM

Users may experience issues uploading a file to a Turnitin assignment using [Safari 12.1](#) (14607.1.40.1.4) on [macOS 10.14 \(Mojave\)](#).

## SOLUTION

There are two options available to resolve the file upload issue:

### OPTION 1 - USE ANOTHER BROWSER (FASTEST SOLUTION)

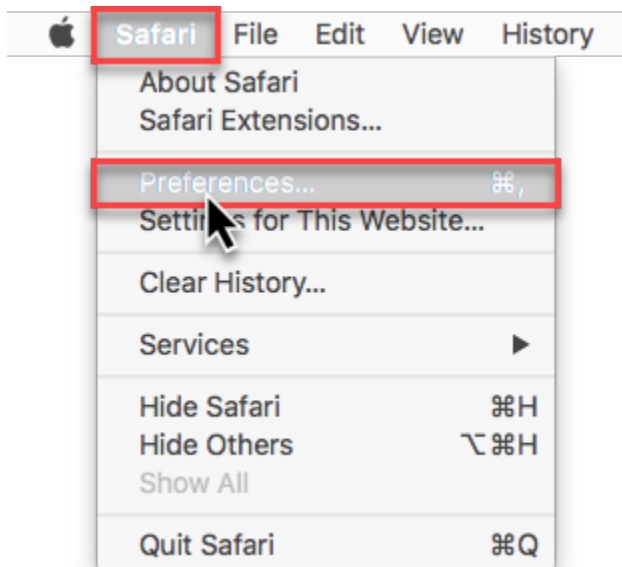
Use [Mozilla Firefox](#) or [Google Chrome](#) to submit your Turnitin file.

### OPTION 2 - DISABLE CROSS-SITE TRACKING IN SAFARI

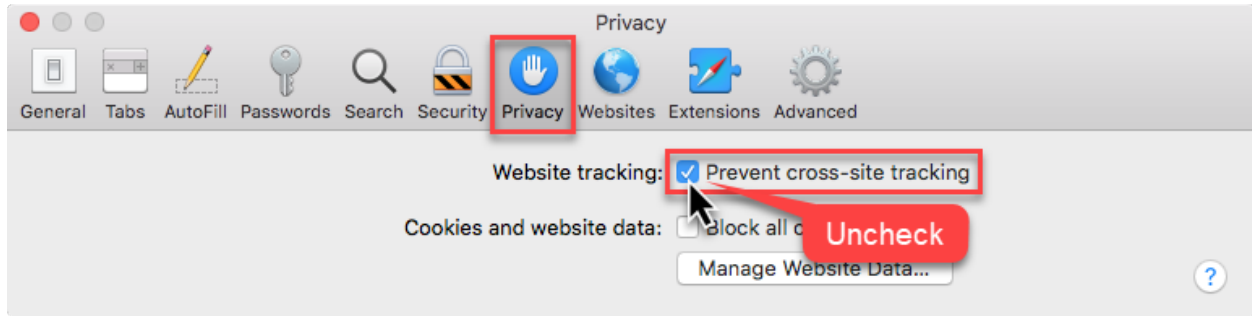
Open Safari's Preferences to temporarily disable cross-site tracking to submit your Turnitin file.

In Safari do the following:

1. Go to **Safari > Preferences**



2. Under **Privacy**, uncheck **Prevent cross-site tracking**



After unchecking the option, attempt to upload the file to Turnitin. After submitting the file, and receiving the Turnitin confirmation email, reenable the feature to prevent [cross-site tracking](#).

## CAUSE

While disabling JavaScript or blocking cookies can disable Blackboard and Turnitin functionality, the Turnitin file upload issue is due to the [cross-site tracking](#) prevention feature found in Safari 12.1 (14607.1.40.1.4) on macOS 10.14 (Mojave).
