

Sending an Email Message

1. In the Course page, click the **Tools** or **Student Tools** link




2. Click the **Send Email** link



3. Select **One** of the following

- » **All Users**
Send email to all of the users in the Course.
- » **All Groups**
Send email to all of the Groups in the Course.
- » **All Teaching Assistant Users**
Send email to all of the Teaching Assistant users in the Course.
- » **All Student Users**
Send email to all of the Student users in the Course.
- » **All Instructor Users**
Send email to all of the Instructor users in the Course.
- » **Select Users**
Select which users will receive the email.
- » **Select Groups**
Select which Groups will receive the email.

- To send an e-mail message to all users in a certain group, select All Users, All Groups, or All Instructor Users.
 - To send a message to a specific user or group, select Select Users or Select Groups and select the users or groups you want to send the message to.
4. Enter a subject for the message in the **Subject** box
 5. Enter e-mail text in the **Message** box
