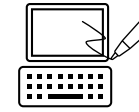

1

Once you authenticate and based on credentials, a qualified user will be presented with their available device(s) options to choose from.

User selects equipment type and pick-up date. A shipping option has been recently added  for select equipment.

We are open M-F from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm (Appointment only)

Once a user submits a request, she will receive a confirmation email with ticket number and contract and URL with instructions to sign the loaner contract online

Reminder emails will be sent in 24, and 48-hour increments, with pick-up instructions, as well as reminder to sign contract if user has not already done so.
