We ask that pieces be no larger than 14" x 18" and no smaller than 81/2" x 11". Photo submissions should be provided as 8"x10" prints or saved onto a CD as a jpeg image. Please apply submissions to card stock mat for display purposes.

Submissions must arrive by March 30th. A selection committee will make final decisions as to which pieces will be displayed at the Fair; winners will be announced on the day of the fair. We will also be photographing submissions and placing them on YouTube as a virtual display.
