Our on-campus MPA Program follows the University's academic calendar with courses offered in the evening and Saturdays. Students will be taking courses year round in their first year and Spring and Fall semesters in final years of study.

Students in our on-campus MPA Program enjoy a number of benefits, including:

Central campus location.

CSUDH is located in the epicenter of LA's thriving South Bay, home to a number of leading nonprofit organizations as well as public entities. The campus is conveniently close to major freeways and public transportation, with downtown Los Angeles just a short drive away.

Flexible schedules.

Our on-campus program offers convenient scheduling for the working adult. Courses meet twice per week, one evening and one Saturday morning, allowing you to balance your work and personal obligations.

Small, collaborative classrooms.

Online MPA Program

online MPA Program include:**

Affordable excellence.

CSUDH's highly respected online MPA Program can be completed for less than half the national average of MPA degree programs. Financial aid is available for MPA students to help you reach your professional goals.

Interactive learning.

Online courses include a high level of regular interaction between students and faculty. You'll have access to your faculty members as well as fellow students through a wide range of channels including online group discussions, video conferencing and email.

Convenient and comprehensive.

Our online MPA courses start and end on a set date, but allow you to complete coursework on your own schedule. Online courses cover the same comprehensive curriculum and rigorous instruction as our on-campus program, without requiring you to physically attend a set class at a specific time. Allowing you the flexibility and freedom to learn anywhere, anytime.

Choice of concentrations.

Online MPA students have the option to select from one of four concentrations that provide a more in-depth study of key issues related to public administration. These include:

- **Public Management**

A general viewpoint on a wide array of public policy issues and organizational perspective in the public sector.

- **Criminal Justice Policy and Administration***

Expand your understanding of administrative law and policy analysis, police administration and ethics, homeland security and terrorism.

- **Healthcare Policy and Administration***

Learn how to effectively lead healthcare organizations with a greater comprehension of legal issues and healthcare policy, the public healthcare system and healthcare financial management.

- **Nonprofit Management***

Cover important topics in the nonprofit and voluntary sector, including leadership and management, fundraising and fund development.

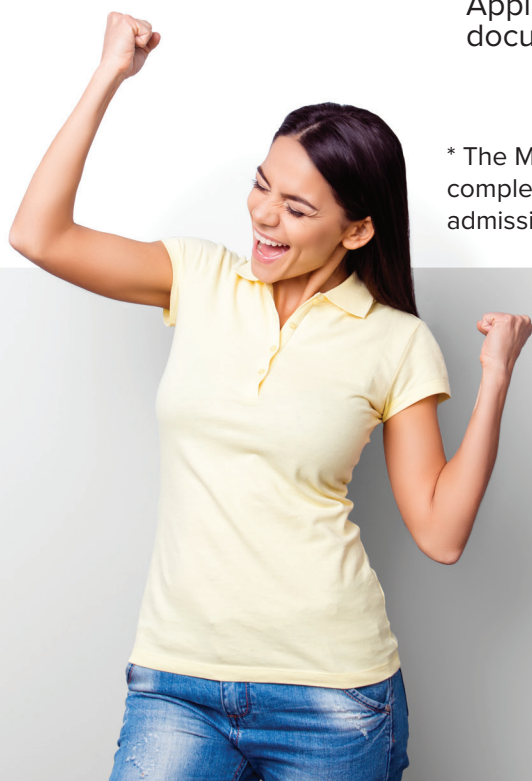
The 12-week online MPA Program accepts new students only in the fall semester.

Admission Requirements

Those applying to the MPA program must meet CSUDH admissions requirements for graduate applicants as well as the MPA admissions requirements set by the College of Business Administration & Public Policy.

Minimum Admission Requirements

To be considered for admission to CSUDH's on-campus or online MPA Program, you must:

- Hold an acceptable baccalaureate degree from a regionally accredited college or university.
- Be in good standing at the last institution attended.
- Have an overall grade point average of at least 3.0 in the last 60 semester (90 quarter) upper division units or 2.75 cumulative grade point average.
- Have taken a college-level math course equivalent to one that meets the university's General Education Reasoning Requirement in CSUDH's Academic Catalog, preferably with a grade of "B" or higher.

How to Apply

- 1) Apply online at **CalState.edu/Apply**. Choose your format: campus, online Public Management, or Cal State Online (Specialized Concentrations).
 - Prompt can be found on MPA website under “How to Apply.”
 - Statement and resume/C.V. can be submitted directly with your online application or to the MPA program at **mpaonline@csudh.edu** as Word or PDF files.
- 2) Pay the nonrefundable **\$70** application fee.
- 3) Have your official transcripts* sent directly from all colleges you have attended to: **CSU Dominguez Hills**
