Student Learning Outcomes Assessment Committee Membership

One University-wide committee to oversee the implementation and assessment of the university academic program assessment plan. The committee will have five faculty members elected by the Academic Senate, with appropriate graduate and undergraduate faculty representation.

The committee will also have one representative from Associated Students Incorporated and the Chair of the University Curriculum Committee or designee.

Non-voting members will include the Vice President for Academic Affairs or designee, and the Director of the Center for Teaching and Learning or designee.

The Outcomes Assessment Coordinator is a faculty member appointed by the Office of Academic Affairs. To ensure staff and advisory support, the Committee will be chaired by the campus Outcomes Assessment Coordinator and will report to the Office of Academic Affairs.

The appointment of the Student Learning Outcomes Assessment (SLOA) Coordinator will be done by the Office of Academic Affairs based upon:

- 1. demonstrated expertise and experience in the field of Student Learning Outcomes Assessment;
- 2. demonstrated expertise and experience in faculty development.

The SLOA Coordinator shall serve a three-year term at which point the succeeding application and selection process will apply. The coordinator may seek a successive three-year term.
