International Education External Advisory Board

An International Education External Advisory Board is hereby established.

- I. Functions of the International Education External Advisory Board. The International Education External Advisory Board (the advisory board) shall work closely with the President, the Vice President for Advancement, and the Senior International Officer to build support for internationalized experiences and learning at CSU Dominguez Hills (the university). This may include the building positive relationships with and securing and support from the following.
 - A. Alumni of the university;
 - B. For-profit businesses, organizations and enterprises that value international perspectives and learning, such as businesses in the local community that engage in commercial activities located outside of the United States;
 - C. Non-profit organizations that define their missions or memberships in global or international terms, and/or in terms of non-American national heritages;
 - D. Other friends in the community.

II. Membership of the International Education External Advisory Board.

- A. The following shall serve ex officio:
 - 1. The University President, who shall chair the advisory board;
 - 2. The Vice President for Advancement, who shall serve as chair *pro tem* in the absence of the President;
 - 3. The Senior International Officer; and
 - 4. A suitable number of other persons holding positions at the university, appointed by the President.
- B. In addition, a suitable number of persons from the community who do not hold positions at the university shall be appointed by the President for three year terms.
