## Spring 2021 Grads and beyond:

- BSN 452 is replacing BSN 430, BSN 450 & BSN 451 (BSN 452 will not require a clinical component)
  - If you have taken any of the following combinations, plan to take the missing coursework during the Summer 2020 or Fall 2020 semesters:
    - BSN 430 <u>but not</u> BSN 450/451 = take BSN 450/451 in the Fall
    - BSN 450 & BSN 451 **but not** BSN 430 = take BSN 430 in the Fall
    - BSN 430 and 450 **but not** BSN 451 = take BSN 451 in the Fall
