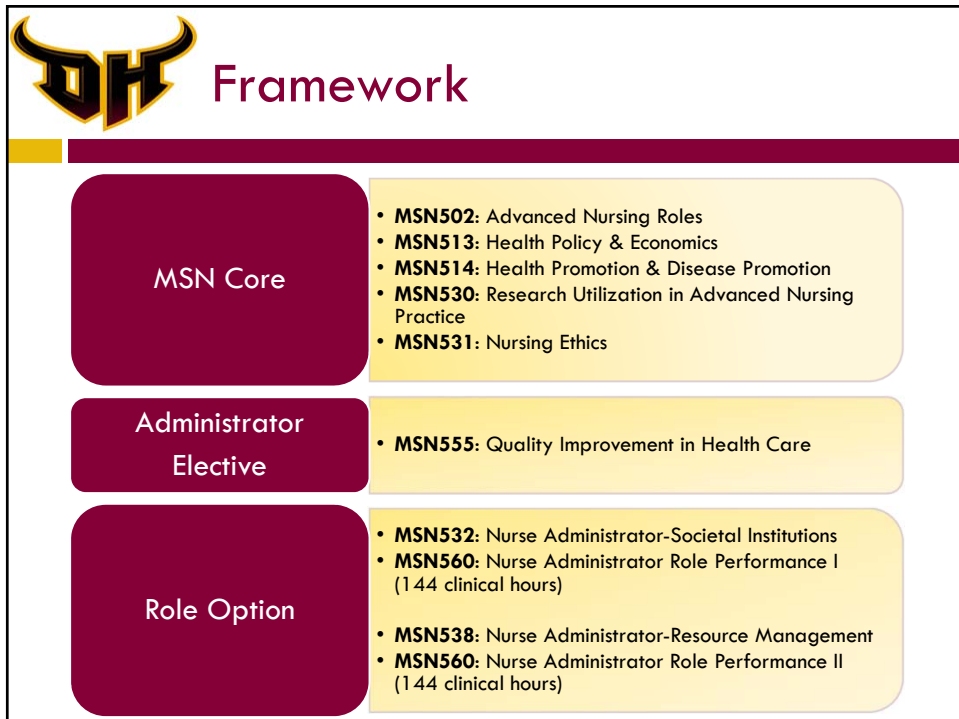

- Prepare for certification or doctoral study

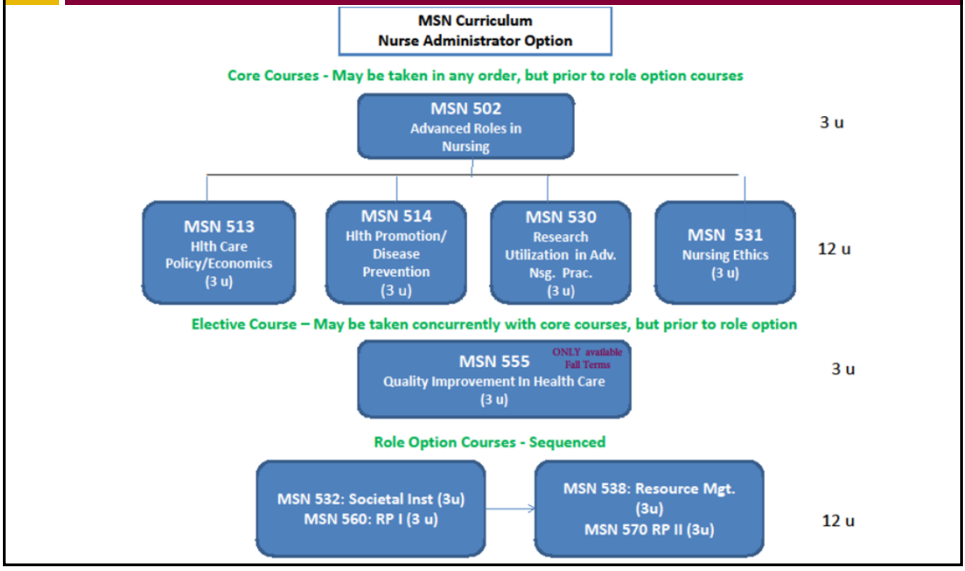

Nurse Administrator Role Performance Courses

- Plan to stay with same preceptor for both semesters
- Refer to Clinical Handbook section for details
- Preceptor qualifications
 - MSN prepared administrator, ideally a “master leader”
 - Experience aligns with future career objective
 - Expertise is congruent with your clinical background
- Preceptor work hours
- No hours in your own unit

 - Apply for Culminating Activity
 - Apply for Graduation
- **The last semester of Role Performance (MSN538/MSN570)**
 - Complete Culminating Activity
