Recycling 101 Guide

Warm Up: Reduce & Reuse!

The best way to support the 3 R's is to do them in order...after all, why create waste in the first place? Reduce and reuse first!



Take Back the Tap and fill up at the fountain or hydration stations.




Use reusables!

Landfill

Styrofoam, plastic bags, paper towels, chip bags, and anything else we can't recycle.

BIN COLOR:

Black or tan/brown

Mixed Recycling

Most #1-7 plastics (hard), soda cups, cartons, office paper and magazines (glossy and regular), cardboard, glass, metal.

BIN COLOR:

Blue

Compost

Food waste: bones, meat, food scraps, cooked and uncooked food.
(Just no packaging other than a clear plastic bag to hold the scraps)

Rule of Thumb for Food

BIN COLOR: Green





Rule of Thumb for Recycling: If it can be melted (plastics, metals, etc.), some food contamination is okay. If it needs to be dissolved (paper, cardboard) then it needs to be clean and dry as oils can contaminate the recycling process.






Food Waste Recycling (Compost) Loker Student Union Loading Dock
