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## **University Student Learning Outcomes Assessment Committee**

(Supercedes PM 02-02)

The University Student Learning Outcomes Assessment Committee (USLOAC) was established to oversee the implementation and assessment of the university academic program assessment plan. The committee has five faculty members elected by the Academic Senate, with appropriate graduate and undergraduate faculty and college representation.

The committee has one representative from Associated Students Incorporated and the Chair of the University Curriculum Committee or designee.

Non-voting members will include the Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs or designee, and the Director of the Center for Teaching and Learning or designee.

To ensure staff and advisory support, the USLOAC will be chaired by the campus Student Learning Outcomes Assessment (SLOA) Coordinator and will report directly to the Vice Provost for Academic Affairs.

The SLOA Coordinator is a faculty member appointed by the Vice Provost for Academic Affairs based upon:

1. demonstrated expertise and experience in the field of Student Learning Outcomes Assessment;
2. demonstrated expertise and experience in faculty development.

The SLOA Coordinator shall serve a three-year term at which point the succeeding application and selection process will apply. The Coordinator may seek a successive three-year term.
